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Exchange platform

Do you want to bring together people who will strengthen and inspire one another on gdd19? An invitation to a network meeting for your employees and colleagues or external guests is the ideal way to do it. The IQ Network Hamburg – NOBI used the format of exchange islands in 2018: successful women with a migration background from various industries gave reports on their professional experiences at five stands. Each stand had a different focus, for example recognition of professional qualifications obtained abroad or female entrepreneurs and networking. It was a wonderful opportunity for role models to share their stories with others and inspire one another.



Escape room

One sealed room, one diverse team, one puzzle: at the Research Institute for Vocational Education and Training, diversity is brought to life, among other things, by using an escape room. Working well together and valuing the talents of each individual are essential to find your way out of this exciting escape room. Participants can break down prejudices through play. Get creative and think about an exciting puzzle that would be an innovative format with which to surprise your staff for gdd19.



Family work room

The ability to reconcile home life and work life is a major challenge for all employers. LEAG AG has a suggestion: a family working room was inaugurated for gdd18. This was a great action with a sustainable impact and would be a good thing to implement in your organisation too. It's not only parents who can use the family room – grandparents, aunts and uncles can also use it to look after children. This means families become more visible in everyday working life and a higher value is placed on them.



Fly the flag with flowers

During gdd18, employees from the International Confederation from the North Rhine-Westphalia North II Region came together to take a brightly coloured stand for diversity. You too can fly the flag by planting a flower bed in the shape of the Diversity Day rings on your company site. An internal community action will give your staff a permanent signal of diversity that visitors will see too.

Flying the flag

Simple yet effective: the gdd18 flag flew above the Molkenmarkt in Berlin for a week. The Berlin Waterworks flew the flag for diversity in the most literal sense of the term with this action, which was a beautiful and clear symbol of diversity to all customers, employees and business partners.
